



# **Get Dual Certified**




Mental Health Community Partners (MHCP) and CarePath™ work hand-in-hand as Tier I/Tier II programs.

## Both programs:

- ✓ Take a relational approach to mental health by supporting the person in recovery, and their family members or chosen supporters
- ✓ Are facilitated by a Mental Health Community Partner or CarePath™ Coach who serves as a peer/supporter
- ✓ Are offered as short-term 90-day programs

Offered together, these programs provide up to **6 months of continued support** – a transformative opportunity for individuals in recovery and their families.



#### Mental Health Community Partners

Supports individuals with high mental health needs, plus their family or chosen supporters, in transitioning from unwell to well.

12 weekly visits to build a foundation for wellness & recovery.

### MHANYS CarePath™

Supports individuals with any level of mental health needs (appropriate for the general population), plus their family or chosen supporters.

5 sessions to sustain recovery & a wellness mindset

# **Dual-Certification Opportunity**

If you are currently certified as either a Mental Health Community Partner or a MHANYS CarePath™ Coach, you are eligible to become a dual-certified provider of both programs.

As a dual-certification trainee, you will engage in further professional development & personal wellness through your second certification training. In total, you can receive up to 32 hours of continuing education credit (12 hours MHCP-specific modules + 12 hours CarePath-specific modules + 8 hours optional skill-building modules).

As a dual-certified Mental Health Community Partner & CarePath<sup>TM</sup> Coach, you'll be able to support continuity of care for your participants, offering support for up to 6 months.
